# **Standing Committee Reports**

**Treasury:** ToniAnn reported checks deposited in the end of September cleared this month. There were a number of expenditures in October including the Region 7 Assembly delegate expenses and convention scholarships. Of the \$312 for the scholarships, \$200 was donated by meetings. The firelight event had to be cancelled due to the current statewide fire hazard; the site will be contacted to obtain a refund of the \$75.00. Donations of 30% to World Service and 10% to Region 7 will be made at the end of the year.

**Oasis:** Mary Ann reported the Winter issue will be coming out before the end of the year. The topic is "God and Me, Perfect Together." Articles are requested by December 1<sup>st</sup> and can be written and sent via the website. There will be a look into the analytics of the Oasis to see how

many visitors to the website opened the Oasis, how many read it and what pages were viewed for the longest time. That should provide an idea of what members like to see.

**Public Information/12 Step Within:** Terry shared that the committee participated with South and Central Jersey intergroup at the social workers convention. There were about 100 attending and about half of them visited the OA information table. There is great benefit to OA from attending conferences, making contact with social workers and medical professionals. Our committee will continue the collaboration of shared expense and work with the other intergroups. Terry asked for help; there is a lot of service which does not include traveling; there are many ways to carry the message and we need more help to do that.

**Scholarship Coordinator:** Susan reported four books were sent out. She is out of Big Books and waiting for a new shipment. The cost of this service is being covered by a donation received from a California intergroup.

**Sponsor Coordinator:** Polly reported nine people reached out for sponsors in October. Presently there hasn't been new contacts from members wanting to be sponsors. Polly has outside sources within OA she gives to the sponsees to contact.

**Suggested:** To maintain local connections between sponsors and sponsees, try speaking to the sponsor coordinator in a HOW meeting, maybe that person would be willing to help. HOW coordinators make a note of people able to sponsor.

**Website:** Steve acknowledged that the website slowness is still a problem. He will follow up with Patrick. He will also look into getting the analytics data for the Oasis; he is not sure if an analytics was set up for the account, if not he will work on setting it up. An update on the recording of DonC: it will be on the site soon but he needs editing to remove the disruptions.

**Zoom:** Steve and Judy will be work to set up the voting for next month and next year's schedule. There are two events in November, the 17<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>. He asked if someone could step in and take the November 17<sup>th</sup> 7 PM event as he has another commitment at that time. ToniAnn volunteered but will have to check her calendar to be sure.

**Region 7:** Loraine reported the 2024 Convention was a success with approximately 200 members attending and 135 names on the WeCare list. The 2025 Convention will be held November 7-9 in Bethesda, MD.

**Events:** Ilene reported that the October 13<sup>th</sup> workshop was great; DonC was the speaker and 114 people attended. The recording will be on the website shortly.
